Evaluating Credibility of Information on the Internet

Some forms include: Access journalism â€“ journalists who self-censor and voluntarily cease speaking about issues that might embarrass their hosts, guests, or powerful politicians or businesspersons.; Advocacy journalism â€“ writing to advocate particular viewpoints or influence the opinions of the audience.; Broadcast journalism â€“ written or spoken journalism for radio or television.
